The Anangu Pitjantjatjara Yankunytjatjara Lands occupy 103,000 square kilometres in the north-west corner of South Australia. The most prominent features on the APY Lands are the Tomkinson, Mann, Musgrave and Everard ranges as they rise from the desert lands to fill the wide blue expanse of cloudless skies. The APY communities are located at the base both in and around these ranges.

Anangu Pitjantjatjara Yankunytjatjara holds the freehold title to the APY Lands. All decisions relating to development, use, access and management of these lands are made at APY general meetings in conjunction with the APY Executive Board of Management.

APY upholds Aboriginal values of culture, respect, inclusivity and integrity.

We seek people who thrive in an environment of change and relish the opportunity to contribute to the development of a values-based organisation which positively impacts the communities it serves.

APY is primarily focused on building economic prosperity through culture and community leadership.
